

Eco Arts & Crafts, Eco Engineering, STEM, and Intro to Robotics Camps are held at the Lawrence Nature Center, 481 Drexel Avenue, Lawrenceville, New Jersey. All other camps are at Rutgers Cooperative Extension of Mercer County, 930 Spruce Street, Lawrenceville, New Jersey – next to the Trenton Farmers Market.

All programs are delivered by Rutgers Department of 4-H Youth Development faculty and staff. Each week is capped at 15-20 youth to help create positive learning environments and to maintain favorable staff to camper ratios.

This year fees are \$225 per week for full day sessions, or \$115 per week for half day sessions. When a child enrolls in more than one week of half day camp, each **additional** week of half day camp is \$100. There is also a **5% Early Bird** discount if the registration form and payment are received by **April 1**. Sibling discounts are not available.

A lunch will need to be sent with your child daily (except for cooking and sewing camps which will include snacks and meals). Additional information, including permission and health forms, will be mailed in June.

Youth will be placed into camps until each week fills – first come, first served. 

