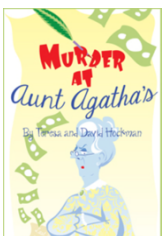

and shoot a video in four days! Designed for writers, actors and directors who are interested in working with the film and videos media, creating original material and collaborating while learning all aspects of producing a short film.



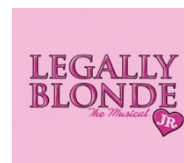
