



Virtual Summer Camps 2020

Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from July 7th to July 23rd

Curriculum: We will teach German through interactive and play-based activities. The following workshops include theater, dance, magic, music, storytelling, arts and crafts, science and more.

The curriculum will differ according to students' ages and language ability.

Duration: 3 weeks. July 7-23, 2020 (except for Adult classes)

Days: Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays

German level: All Language Levels

Mode of courses: Online using Zoom

Discount: 2 %, if paid through ACH Transfer (electronic check)

All courses are subject to a minimum enrollment of 5 students.

Family collaboration is essential in this educational environment, especially for those students under the age of 9, as you will be asked to help your children connect and disconnect to Zoom, as well as monitor behavior, recess and provide the materials needed for classes and workshops.

Virtual Summer Camp sessions will utilize Zoom to communicate. The teachers will create a recurrent session so that the students /families can access to every session with the same link.

Week 1: Es war einmal....Deutsche Märchen (German Fairy Tales): Our virtual campers will get to know different types of fairy tales as well as their characteristics. They will read, act, with the opportunity to create their very own tale.

Week 2: Wir packen unseren Koffer (Let's pack our bags): Students expand their knowledge of culture, points of interest, and geography by taking virtual trips to German-speaking countries.

Week 3: Mint für Kinder und Pre-Teens (STEAM = *Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Math*) Camp: Students will explore basic science, nature, environment and art, while strengthening your German skills and learning new vocabulary. Session include hands-on activities, experiments, and crafts.

- **Time:** 10am to 12:00pm (includes a short break)
